Collaborative exchange

A diverse community of stakeholders from Gavi transitioning countries who exchange their knowledge and experiences managing key immunization functions during transition, and periodically share where they are in the transition process.



Knowledge management

Gathering, managing, and sharing relevant transition information with LNCT members so that they can use it to act effectively and efficiently



Learning

Synthesis and sharing improves the availability and quality of insight on country lessons, good practices, and key management challenges. Better implementation insight supports learning by bridging theory- what you should do- and actual country experiences



Catalyzing linkages

Bridging the gap between theory and practice generates actionable lessons, guidance, or tools that help catalyze new linkages to match supply and demand for support on transition
