## Potential questions and challenges

- Are we sourcing safe and effective vaccines from local manufacturers, global manufacturers, and/or UNICEF SD?
- Does registration, inspection, surveillance, etc. differ for locally-sourced and imported products?
- Do we have the structures, knowledge and capacities to undertake vaccine quality assurance activities?
- Do we have a functional NRA? How can we ensure our NRA is fulfilling its functions?
- Are we complying with WHO norms, standards and requirements?
- Are we assuring the quality of vaccines from the point of import and production till the point of administration?
- How many vaccines are PQ by WHO? Is this fully reliable?
- What roles are played by the UN agencies compared to countries on vaccine quality assurance?
- How should we approach quality assurance with non-PQ vaccines?
- Are there vaccines being considered that are not available through UNICEF? Are they of assured quality?
- Could we rely on Market Authorization delivered by neighboring countries?
- Could we collaborate at regional or sub-regional level on vaccine quality? What are the current experiences and initiatives within the region?
- How are partners supporting capacity building in participating countries and in the region?
